This is going to give you a BRIEF rundown of the first stepping stones needed to start your journey as a theologian!

Being conformed to the image of Jesus and knowing God is not something that happens overnight and intentionality is essential as we journey through this life!

I hope this little packet helps give you some practical information to get your journey started!

Just so we're clear....

A theologian is: a person who engages or is an expert in theology (the study of the nature of God).

Usually that term is used to describe some of the pioneers and thought leaders in the Christian space, but I believe that God wants EVERY believer to have their own study, experiences, and relationship with Him.

Let's get serious about diving into His Word and understanding it for ourselves!







Prayer

This may seem obvious, but it's so important that we don't try to "figure out" our relationship with God... without God! Prayer is a way to humble ourselves before Him and keep our relationship with Him at the forefront of our minds as we venture into the Bible.

Mentorship / Discipleship

Find someone in your local church that can help you as you learn and grow spiritually. It's so helpful to have someone to direct your questions to and be there as extra support. God gave us the gift of community with other believers for a reason!

Get A Bible

You can use an app, print pages from online or purchase a Bible! It doesn't matter the format you choose, but obviously it's required if you're going to spend time studying it!

*I recommend a tangible Bible that's in the ESV or CSB translation. This way you can write notes in it and highlight things that stick out! Plus you don't have to worry about distracting notifictions interrupting you!

Make A Plan

Decide what you're going to read each day for the next month and when! For example, it might be easy to wake up 30 minutes early and read a chapter each day or dedicate an hour after work to venture through the Psalms!


It can be hard to be consistent in our Bible reading without some goals and a firm plan in place so think of how you can set yourself up for success! Once you choose how much time vou can set aside each day, be dedicated to reaching that goal. Consistency is key!

This is a great step to add your mentor in to! They can help you think about where you should start reading and act as an accountability partner!

*If you're totally lost on where to start just begin in the New Testament and try to read 3 chapters a day!







Remember:

It's okay if there's things in the text that you don't understand in the first read through! Write down your questions and ask your friends or leaders at church! Remember that studying God's Word is something that is a lifelong endeavor. There will never come a day where you "master" the Bible and never have to read it again!

You'll always find yourself going deeper, understanding more and analyzing different things that you never noticed before!

Hopefully that takes some pressure off and allows you to sit with these God breathed words and enjoy them for the day. Whatever things you notice (or not), the stuff you understand and the places you need leave question marks to revisit later... it's all apart of critically thinking through the scriptures and it's good progress!

See your study time as a time to dig in and discover more of God! It's like a fun treasure hunt where you'll always find something!

Prayer I can't stress how much prayer matters! Studying God through the Words of the Bible is not meant to happen without seeking Him. Reading the Bible and understanding its context should stregthen our personal relationship with God and make our prayers stronger
